Reviewing Officer Involved Shooting

- Sets standards and timelines for the County Attorney when reviewing an officer involved shooting.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1- County Home Rule Implementation- Duties of the County Attorney (331.756)

When there is an officer involved shooting, that results in serious injury or death, the county attorney shall review the evidence and give a written opinion and charging decision, convene a grand jury, or refer the case to the Attorney General.

The written report detailing the results shall be provided to the officer and their employing agency within 180 days of the county attorney receiving the evidence.

If there is a conflict of interest the review shall be sent to an independent county attorney, the Attorney General, or a Special Prosecutor.
