Charter School Extracurricular Activities

- If a charter school does not offer an extracurricular activity, a charter school student may participate in the activity in their resident district.
- Charter school students will be counted as 1/10 of a pupil in the school district.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1. Section 256E.13 New Section—Extracurricular Athletic Activities

If a charter school does not offer a particular extracurricular athletic activity, a student enrolled in the charter school may participate in the extracurricular athletic activity provided by the student's school district of residence.

If a student participates in an extracurricular athletic activity the student shall be included in the district's basic enrollment and counted as 1/10 of one pupil.

The State Board may adopt rules.

Section 2. Section 257.6(1)(a) New Subparagraph

Resident pupils enrolled in a charter school who participate in extracurricular activities will be counted as 1/10 of one pupil.
