EOB – Secondary Insurance

- This bill requires primary insurance to send a copy of the explanation of benefits to the secondary insurer within 20 days.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1- New Section (Iowa Code 514A.16)

Defines “covered person”, “explanation of benefits”, “health benefit plan”, and “health care services”.

Requires primary insurance to send a copy of an explanation of benefits to the secondary insurer if requested by the secondary insurer within 20 days.

Amendment Analysis

H-1112 by Boden – Requires health care providers to submit a claim for reimbursement to your primary health insurer prior to submitting to any secondary coverage, defines “personal representative”, allows a covered person’s personal representative, like a parent, to request an EOB be sent, and changes the deadline to send the EOB from 20 days to 30 days to align with HIPAA.
