Land Surveyor Licensing

- Redefines educational requirements for professional land surveyor licensing.
- Allows the licensing board more options for the examination of surveyor applicants.

Section by Section Analysis

<u>Section 1 – General requirements for licensure — temporary permit to practice engineering (Iowa Code</u> 542B.14(1)(b))

Amends the educational requirements for professional land surveyors to require 2 years of college courses in mathematics and basic science courses. Previously surveyors needed more prescriptive science courses and at least 6 years of practical experience.

Allows the board to have more than one exam required for determining qualification for licensure.

Section 2 - EFFECTIVE DATE Takes effect on July 1, 2023

Section 3 - APPLICABILITY

Applies to applications submitted on or after the enactment date.
