Retirement Age of Peace Officers and Fire Fighters

- SF 183 clarifies the retirement age for peace officers and firefighters

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1- Definitions and Miscellaneous Provisions- Police Officers and Fire Fighters (362.10)

Under current law the maximum age for a police officer, marshal, or firefighter employed for duty is 65. This does not apply to volunteer firefighters.

The bill clarifies the following people must retire at 65:

- Police officers, law enforcement as defined in Iowa code, or marshals employed full time or part time for law enforcement duties
- Paid professional firefighter employed full or part time for the duty of fighting fires

This does not apply to reserve peace officers or a volunteer fire fighter
