Rescheduling Annual Tax Sales

- Amends Code to allow county treasurers with good cause to reschedule the annual tax sale within 120 days of the third Monday of June.
- If necessary to reschedule a second time, the Board of Supervisors must approve the change.
- Currently county treasurers are only allowed to reschedule for a different date in June.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1 – Annual tax sale (Iowa Code 446.7(1))

Amends code to allow a county treasurer, with good cause, to reschedule a different time within 120 days after the 3rd Monday in June. If it is necessary to change the date again, the Treasurer needs the Board of Supervisors' approval to designate another date, not more than 120 days after the first postponed date.
