### Juvenile Justice

- In 2022, the code section addressing early intervention and follow-up programs for juveniles by the Department of Health and Human Services was repealed. This responsibility is being moved to the Judicial Branch under this bill. The responsibilities are the same but the department and funding has moved.

### Section by Section Analysis

#### Section 1 – Juvenile Justice- Juvenile Justice Delinquency Prevention (232.192)

Contingent on a specific appropriation for these purposes the judicial branch shall develop programs for youth in the juvenile court system. The program shall focus on community safety and ensure programming is matched to youth risk levels and individual needs.

Repeals code sections no longer needed.
