Who Administers Driver's Education Final Driving Test

- Senate File 157 changes Iowa law to allow the final driving test of a driver's education course to be administered by a qualified driver's ed classroom instructor or those qualified to provide driving instruction. Current law requires the final test to be given by a classroom instructor.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1 (Iowa Code 321.178 (1) (c)):

The section amends current Iowa Code to expand the list of who can administer a final driving test to driver's education students. Iowa Code section 321.178 (1) (c) is amended to allow the final test to be given by a qualified classroom driver's education instructor or by a qualified driving instructor.
