Waldorf ITG

- Allows Waldorf students to be eligible to receive the Iowa Tuition Grant.
- Fiscal Note: Allows the distribution of previously appropriated funding for for-profit ITGs from the General Fund totaling \$170,000.

Section by Section Analysis

Division I—For-Profit Institutions

Section 1. Iowa Tuition Grants—For-Profit

For the period beginning December 1, 2022 and ending June 20, 2023, an eligible institution shall include an institution of higher learning accredited by the higher learning commission, which was purchased by a for-profit in 2020, but in 2022 was purchased by a not-for-profit.

Section 2. Effective Date

Effective upon enactment.

Section 3. Retroactive Applicability

Applies retroactively to December 1, 2022.

Division II—Iowa Tuition Grants Program

Section 4. Section 261.9(3)

Strikes for-profit schools language and only lists barber and cosmetology schools.

Section 5. Section 261.16A(2)

Strikes for-profit language.

Section 6. Section 261.25(2)

Makes conforming changes.
