Podiatrists License After 2 Years of Residency

- Amends code to allow someone who has completed 2 years of an approved residency to apply for a podiatrist license.
- If granted a license before the completion of the residency, proof of completion is required for renewal of a license.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1 – License (Iowa Code 149.3(4))

Amends code to allow a person to apply for a podiatry license after completing 2 years of a Council on Podiatric Medical Education approved residency. The first renewal of a podiatry license shall require the documentation showing the completion of the residency program.
