Alcohol Trade Practice Rules

- Directs the Department of Revenue to adopt administrative rules to conform to federal regulations with an exemption allowing wholesalers to reset or rearrange alcoholic beverages with the consent of the retailer or the manufacturer/wholesaler of the product.
- Directs the Department of Revenue to adopt administrative rules to prohibit a manufacturer or wholesaler from offering sale incentives to retailers.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1 – Federal regulations adopted as rules — penalties (Iowa Code 123.176(2A,2B))

Directs the Department of Revenue to adopt exemptions to sections of the federal code as administrative rule to allow industry members to move and set alcoholic beverage displays with the permission of the retailer and to prohibit a manufacturer or wholesaler from offering sale incentives to retailers.
