Alternating Proprietorship Arrangements for Beer Manufacturers

• Authorizes brewpubs to brew beer for other class "A" beer permit holders if there is a proprietorship arrangement approved by the Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau of the US. Treasury.

Section by Section Analysis

<u>Section 1 – Retail alcohol licenses — classes (lowa Code 123.30(3)(b)(2))</u> Allows brewpubs to hold a special class "A" beer permit.

Section 2 – Authority under class "A" and special class "A" beer permits (Iowa Code)

Amends code to allow brewpubs to manufacture beer for an alternating proprietorship arrangement. Beer manufactured under the agreement cannot be sold for consumption or for retail without a special class "C" license for the location.

<u>Section 3 – Authority under class "A" and special class "A" beer permits (lowa Code 123.130(4A))</u>
Allows a manufacturer of beer to use the space and equipment of another manufacturer if there is an agreement in place and approved by the Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau.
