Regulating Kickboxing Events

- Adds kickboxing events to code chapter on boxing, MMA, and wrestling.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1 – Definitions (Iowa Code 90A.1)

NEW SUBSECTION – defines “kickboxing match” as a professional or amateur kickboxing event that an admission fee is charged or donation is requested and merchandise or refreshments are available for purchase.

Section 2 – Definitions (Iowa Code 90A.1(9))

NEW PARAGRAPH – adds kickboxing matches into the definition of “promoter”.

Section 3 – License (Iowa Code 90A.2(1))

Adds kickboxing to current code requiring licenses for promoters.

Section 4 – Suspensions, denials, and revocations (Iowa Code 90A.6)

Adds kickboxing to current code concerning licenses for promoters.

Section 5 – Written report filed — tax due — penalty (Iowa Code 90A.9)

Adds kickboxing to current code concerning promoters reporting tickets sold, admission proceeds, and other matters prescribed by the commissioner.
