Concurrent Enrollment Course Delivery

- If a community college offers a concurrent enrollment course in-person and online, the student must be enrolled in the in-person course unless the superintendent authorizes them to enroll in the online course.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1 Section 261E.8(3)

If a community college offers a course in-person and online, the high school student must enroll in the in-person course unless the superintendent authorizes them to enroll in the online course.

The superintendent shall consider if the student is prepared for and likely to be successful in an online course.

The superintendent may consider any other factors deemed relevant including but not limited to scheduling conflicts that may impact their ability to participate in the in-person course.
