Protective Orders

- Allows a peace officer to file for a 72-hour emergency protection order for a victim, if requested.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1- Domestic Abuse- Emergency Orders (236.6)

A peace officer may file a petition for a 72-hour emergency protective order on an individual's behalf if the person claims to be in present danger of domestic abuse, and the person requests the peace officer submit the petition.
