Intimidation with a Dangerous Weapon

- Changes the definition of intimidation with a dangerous weapon. Removes the requirement that an assembly of people must be present.
- **Fiscal Note** – Cannot be estimated.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1 – Assault- Intimidation with a Dangerous Weapon (708.6)

Removes references to using weapons in crowds and instead targets the law at actions or threats aimed directly at people or occupied places.

It keeps the current felony penalties but makes it clearer that the offense applies specifically when individuals or occupied buildings or vehicles are targeted.
