

BOARD MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES

lowa Organic Association is a statewide education and advocacy organization committed to advancing organic opportunities through education, research, policy, promotion and market development.

IOA strives to provide a collective voice on behalf of lowa's organic community by ensuring its board membership embodies:

- Support for IOA mission driven priorities and programs.
- Inclusive representation of organic interests: producer, processor, academics, consumer, retailer/wholesaler, NGO, advocate.
- Geographical diversity.

Responsibilities of an Iowa Organic Association board member:

- 1. Serve a 3-year term.
- 2. Provide an annual membership to the organization (\$50).
- 3. Attend a majority of scheduled board meetings (in person or by phone). Board meetings are scheduled every other month (6 per year).
- 4. Participate on a board committee (Policy, Education/Outreach, and Development). Committee meetings are scheduled during the off months of board meetings.
- 5. Support membership and sponsorship solicitation efforts.
- 6. Recruit new board members.
- 7. Participate in IOA activities, events and programs; and regional organic conference, events and workshops (when available).
- 8. Provide feedback and advice on organization goals, priorities, and programs.
