

Republican Party of Jackson County Policies on the Support of Candidates and Elected Officials following a Party Endorsement.

The following policies govern the Republican Party of Jackson County monetary, in-kind, and volunteer support of candidates and elected officials. These policies take effect following any endorsement vote and remain in effect until a subsequent endorsement vote or the associated partisan primary election. For Republican Party of Wisconsin and Republican Party Congressional District endorsements, this policy only applies to those races with party endorsed candidates.
