Fall Session 2018: Program Descriptions

Grade	Day(s)	Club
K-2	T	Drama Club - Stamos. Students will create and tell stories through acting and pantomime. Students will also play improvisation games, learning to express themselves by creating and acting out different characters.
K-2	Th	Primary Math Intervention - Koehn. Come join us for multi-sensory math. Students will practice primary concepts through games, songs, and hands on activities. We will sharpen skills in a fun setting with friends and get excited about numbers.
K-2	T, Th	Primary Reading Intervention - Lewis. Let's get some extra reading while making inferences, looking for main ideas and supporting details, and learning new vocabulary.
1-3	T	Ballet - Victorson. After school ballet students will be introduced to ballet through beginning level technique activities and creative dance games.
2-4	Th	Choir - Esquivel. Choir is a fun opportunity for students to come together and make beautiful music. If you love music and you love to sing, then this is the club for you! Choir is a great way to learn about different types of music all while making you a better musician.
3-5	Th	Intermediate Reading Intervention Meyers. - Let's get in some extra reading while making inferences, look for main ideas and supporting details, and learn new vocabulary.
5-8	T	Middle School Math Intervention - Akrabawi. Students will receive small group and individual support to develop their understanding of mathematical concepts and their exposure to the rigor that is expected of them in high school.
6th	F	6th Grade Band - Esquivel. Band is a fun opportunity for students to come together and make beautiful music. If you love music and want to learn how to play an instrument, then this is the club for you! If students choose to join band, they will have the opportunity to play fun music with their peers!
5-8	Th	Art Club - Lynch. Middle school students will have the opportunity to create both collaborative and independent artist work based on their own personal interest. Students will plan and create school wide beautification projects. Students will end the program with a personal portfolio of their artistic work.
5-8	W	Middle School Reading - Meyers. Let's get some extra reading while making inferences, looking for main ideas and supporting details, and learning new vocabulary.
5-8	M	Dance Ensemble - Victorson. Dance Ensemble students learn new dances and develop ideas for their own choreography. We study modern and contemporary dance and perform at least twice a year at Jahn events. This group is for middle school students who wish to improve their dance technique and enjoy more performance opportunities.
5-8	W	Student Council - Berrios - Invitation only. Students develop leadership skills and organize events around the school.
