December 30, 2025 Tomball, TX – In a electrifying display of conservative leadership, Congressional candidate Jeff Yuna dominated the My God Votes Candidate Forum for Texas District 38, earning cheers and laughter from the crowd as the only contender bold enough to champion a federal elimination of property taxes on homesteads, mirroring Governor Greg Abbott's aggressive push to abolish school property taxes at the state level.

Held on December 18, 2025, at Glorious Way Church in Houston, the forum featured seven Republican candidates vying for the open seat vacated by Rep. Wesley Hunt. But it was Yuna, a 6th-generation Texan, serial entrepreneur, and owner of Tomball Pawn & Jewelry, one of Texas's largest firearms dealers, who stole the show. Drawing on his real-world experience witnessing families pawn heirlooms to pay skyrocketing property taxes, Yuna unveiled his flagship proposal: introducing the 28th Amendment to constitutionally ban property taxes on homesteads nationwide.

"The crowd cheered, applauded, even laughed in agreement, as I connected directly with their struggles," said Yuna. "While others dodged or diluted the issue, I stood firm: No more forcing Texans to choose between their homes and their heritage. Governor Abbott is leading the charge to end school property taxes in Texas, and I'll take that fight to Washington to crush this injustice at the federal level. It's time for real relief, not more empty promises from career politicians."

Yuna's no-nonsense style resonated deeply, outshining opponents including out-of-state transplants and big-spending insiders. Attendees praised his authenticity, with one voter noting, "Jeff speaks like one of us, straight talk, no fluff." His agenda also includes funding the border wall, deporting illegal aliens, defunding sanctuary cities, imposing term limits, removing the COVID vaccine from the market, and banning congressional stock trading, all backed by signed pledges.

As a proven entrepreneur in six industries, husband, father of four, and grandfather of five, Yuna is no Washington insider. "I've built businesses from the ground up in Texas soil. Now, I'm fighting to restore our freedoms, secure our borders, and end government overreach that's crippling the middle class," Yuna added.

This standout performance positions Yuna as the frontrunner in the March 2026 Republican primary, signaling a seismic shift toward bold, America First conservatism in District 38.
