WESTCONNEX

The Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the M4 East Tunnel has been released. To see how this polluting tollway affects your suburb and to make a submission go to majorprojects.planning.nsw.gov.au

Residents across the inner west need to **make a submission** to the EIS and tell the NSW Government we oppose this \$15.4 billion polluting tollway and should be investing the money in public transport.

COUNCIL AMALGAMATIONS

The Baird Government's forced council amalgamations threaten vital services including swimming pools, parks, libraries and Marrickville's Magic Yellow Bus. The Government is due to release information on their plans shortly. As your local member, I'll be fighting alongside our local councils to protect local services and communities.

OUR HERITAGE BUILDINGS

Sydney-siders love our sandstone buildings. The Baird Government is planning to outsource the jobs of expert stonemasons and heritage trades-people to save a few dollars. This threatens the upkeep of our heritage school buildings, courthouses, train stations and hospitals.
