

MAKING RENTING IN NSW FAIRER

The Minns Labor Government is delivering on its election commitment to improve rental laws and help make renting fairer for tenants in NSW.

This month in Parliament, we will introduce a suite of reforms to make the rental system fairer in NSW. They include:

- Ending no grounds evictions
- Banning fees for background checks
- Ensuring tenants have a free way to pay rent
- Making it easier for tenants to have pets in rentals

This is alongside improvements we've already made, like introducing the Portable Bonds scheme and establishing the Rent Check feature on the NSW Fair Trading website, where you can check how the rent you're paying compares to similar properties in your area.
