## NSW BUDGET DELIVERING FOR THE INNER WEST SUPERCHARGING ELECTRIC VEHICLE INFRASTRUCTURE ROLL-OUT

**136 new electric vehicle chargers are coming to the Inner West as the NSW State Government makes a major investment to help electric vehicle owners boost up!**

The NSW Government is making it easier to make the choice to switch to electric vehicles with a \$209 million investment in the 2024 State Budget.

This includes \$149 million for EV fast chargers and \$10 million to co-fund retrofitting electric vehicle chargers in apartment buildings across the State, including right here in the Inner West.

# \$6.6 BILLION TO BUILD AFFORDABLE HOUSING

## BUILDING 8,400 PUBLIC HOMES

**We are making the biggest investment in public housing in NSW history.**

We want to ensure vulnerable people have access to affordable, secure and well-maintained housing.

Half of these new homes will be dedicated to victim-survivors of domestic and family violence, because you can't leave violence unless you have a safe place to go.



## SUPPORTING RENTERS


The State Budget invests \$8.4 million to establish a NSW Rental Taskforce to support renters and create a fairer rental market. The funding will deliver investigators, inspectors and support teams to engage with renters, target dodgy agents and act on serious breaches of rental laws.





# INVESTING IN OUR COMMUNITY'S HEALTH



## The Budget delivers a record \$35.1 billion in health funding across NSW. This includes:

- Support for bulk-billing to protect the cost of seeing a GP
- Bolstering emergency departments, including funding for more staff
- \$3.4 billion to upgrade hospitals and health facilities across the State, including Canterbury Hospital
- Expanding Community Mental Health Teams across NSW
- \$39 million to establish a new Mental Health Single Front Door to make it easier to access mental health support
