

# CIRCULATOR INSTRUCTIONS

## WASHINGTON PETITION

### ROBERT F. KENNEDY JR.

1. Each petition page **MUST** be printed on 8 ½ x 11” paper, in Landscape format – NO EXCEPTIONS.
2. So, Washington is a little odd, in that they call the circulation of a petition a “nominating convention.” The location of a “nominating convention” is the city you are circulating this petition. Accordingly, record the name of the city where you are circulating this petition in the space provided as part of the “voter’s oath” section. Voters from other counties or cities may sign this petition, but they may only sign while they are in this city (or, as the petition calls it, while they “attended” the convention in this city).
3. You **MUST** be at least 18 years old to circulate this petition.
4. You **MUST** witness (or watch) each voter as they sign this petition.
5. You may NOT misrepresent the purpose of this petition.

The sole purpose of this petition to place the name of Robert F. Kennedy Jr. on Washington’s 2024 general election ballot as a candidate for the office of President of the United States. You cannot collect a signature by telling a voter the petition is to “Save America” or “Help the Poor.” BE HONEST WITH THE VOTERS.

6. Voters **MUST** use only black or blue ballpoint pens to sign this petition. Do not use gel pens as they can easily smear and result in an invalid signature.
7. Only registered voters may sign this petition.
8. Each voter must:
  - A. Sign their name; and,
  - B. Print their first name in the space provided; and,
  - C. Print their last name in the space provided; and,
  - D. Record the date they sign this petition; and,

- E. Record their residential address as it is recorded on their voter registration record; and,
  - F. Record the city where they reside; and,
  - G. Record the zip code for their residential address.
9. Return the **ORIGINAL** of each petition to the campaign.
