Position Summary: This position is responsible to lead, promote, and coordinate the effort to collectively impact the number of Native Hawaiians achieving STEAM post-secondary studies, careers and businesses here in Hawai'i. The Director is charged to pursue the goals of the Lononuiākea by employing its principle strategies.

Goals of Lononuiākea Collective Impact Project

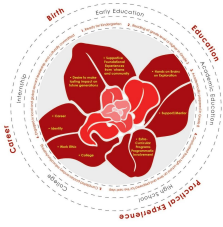
- To accomplish the Lononuiākea community level indicators
- To establish and reach targets of educational achievement ranging from kindergarten readiness through post baccalaureate career attainment and achievement.
- To engage partners from East Hawai'i in the establishment and pursuit of these targets.

Principle strategies with the StriveTogether are:

- Establish a shared community vision for cradle-to-career educational achievement, engaging broadest possible set of cross-sector partners.
- Develop and employ data-defined targets for measuring improvements in educational achievement at all levels including:
 - Kindergarten readiness
 - Third grade reading and math
 - Successful graduation and prepared for post-secondary success.
 - Successful post-secondary graduation in STEAM field of study and then engaged in STEAM career.
- Encourage collaborative action networks engaging cross-sector practitioners in identifying, adopting and scaling practices that improve student outcomes at various levels.
- Raise funds sufficient to support the activity of Lononuiākea.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Secure the broadest possible array of partners across East Hawai'i committed to pursuit of these targets.
- Assist with the formation of collaborative action networks at all targeted levels of achievement.
- Establish effective communication networks among partners across the community.
- Develop and lead a sustained marketing effort encouraging educational achievement across East Hawai'i.
- Work with the Leadership Table to develop resources sufficient to sustain the work of Lononuiākea.
- Align Lononuiākea with high caliber national initiatives, including StriveTogether.
- Manage the personnel and affairs of Lononuiākea and sustain strong collaborative relationships with the Board and other key constituents.
- Other responsibilities as assigned



Qualifications

- High level of credibility with community and educational leadership by virtue of demonstrated capacity to lead, commitment to collaboration, and passion for excellence in Lononuiākea.
- Effective fundraiser and grant writer.
- Capable of facilitator, public speaker and committed to effective communications across all sectors.
- Capacity to work independently and self-direction.
- Bachelors degree in related field.
- Experience in working within the Native Hawaiian community.
