awards calendar. Nominations were sought across a variety of categories including best value restaurant, best takeaway, best new restaurant and chef of the year. The awards honour the classic takeaway through to the growing number of family restaurants serving kebab style food.

Kebabs have become a Great British institution. And they are big business, with an estimated 1.3m kebabs sold by vendors every day in the UK. The first kebab shop opened in North London in 1960s and there are now estimated over 20,000 kebab outlets in the UK. Their popularity slowly increased in the 1970s and 1980s with the influx of Turkish and Greek Cypriots and Kurdish communities. The origin of the word kebab can be traced back to Mesopotamia.

A panel of judges including MPs Nadhim Zahawi, Jonathan Reynolds, Andy Love and Keith Vaz, as well as Baroness Hussein-Ece, helped to decide the winners of each category. The 2015 awards are sponsored by JUST EAT, world's leading online takeaway ordering service,

as well as Big K, Xpo-online, Levenes, Harlequin Print group, Alton & Co and Bulldog Energy Drinks and Paragon Qualities Food with the aim of showcasing the wide range of restaurants serving kebab styled food.

The British kebab industry contributes over £2.2 billion annually to the British economy, supporting around 200,000 jobs across restaurants, suppliers and the food industry in the UK. There are also around 200 doner kebab manufacturers in the UK, with a turnover in excess of £750m.

Kebabs have become a Great British institution. And they're big business, with an estimated 1.3m kebabs sold by vendors every day in the UK. Over 20,000 kebab outlets in the UK selling around 2,500 tonnes of lamb and chicken doner a week.

The British kebab industry contributes over £2.2 billion annually to the British economy, supporting around 200,000 jobs across restaurants, suppliers and the food industry in the UK. There are also around 200 doner kebab manufacturers in the UK, with a turnover in excess of £750m.

British Kebab Awards (2015) in its third year have received over 200 nominations across Great Britain. More and more kebab businesses are recognised for their good food and hard work.

History of the Doner Kebab

It is suggested that the doner kebab was invented in 1970s by immigrants from Turkey who moved to Germany and transformed the kebab into a mobile dish. Traditionally, kebab had been served with rice, but in a moment of inspiration, they saw that the future lay in putting the kebab inside a pitta bread. Taking away a kebab dish on the go seemed much easier. ■

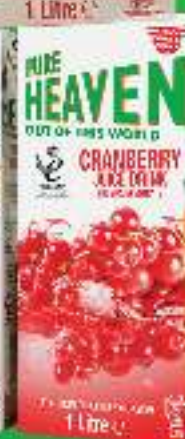

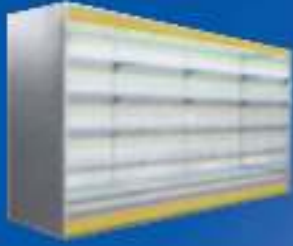

Samuel Muston: The great chefs skewering each other at the Kebab Awards

The news that Mangal 2's Ali Dirik won the best chef gong at Tuesday's British Kebab Awards will come as little surprise to artists Gilbert and George. Every night with the regularity of a German express train, the pair pootle up London's Kingsland Road from their house in Spitalfields and dine here, each time going through the same ritual of handing their coats to the waiting staff when they sit (unknown for normal punters) and being helped to put them on again when they rise to leave.

You may be thinking, why do a pair of famous artists with vast wealth spend each evening eating kebabs in north-east London? To which the answer is: because Mangal is brilliant. It is an education in what you can do with meat, a skewer and an exceptionally hot grill. And its regular clientele, among which I number myself, love it with a passion. I realise loving a doner, shish or kofte might be incomprehensible to some. Because foods, like people, have reputations. Soufflés, for

THE INDEPENDENT

instance, are haughty, flighty and no friend of the Saturday cook; burgers, the food of the dude, are unkempt, oily. Few dishes, though, carry anything like the burden of the kebab. To say it has a bad rep is like saying Hitler was a bit naughty. It is widely perceived as nothing more than a beer soaker-upper, the postscript to a night on the lager.

And to an extent, that characterisation is spot on. Kebab shops contribute £2.2bn to the British economy; and, as you would expect with any "industry" of that size, quality varies. Anyone who has ever spent the evening drinking, found the ever-rotating elephant leg to suddenly take on a mythic appeal and suffered for it the next day, can easily believe that a bad doner can contain up to 98 per cent and 148 per cent, respectively, of your RDA of salt and saturated fat. But it doesn't have to be so.

When Turkish émigré Kadir Nurman invented the doner kebab – also known as a shawarma or

gyros – in Berlin in 1972, the meat he served in his salad-filled pittas was not highly processed and indeterminate. What he doled out was a fresh feast for Berliners on the go. And it is to this that the British Kebab Awards hope shop owners will return. Its method of persuasion: big, shiny trophies.

So on Tuesday, the great and the good of the kebab grill met at London's Park Lane Sheraton Hotel to hear the results of the 11-category awards. Is this Islington's best kebab?

The kebab. The final refuge of the drunken Londoner before the chastening ride home in the night bus. Or so you thought but at Archway Kebab House on Junction Road, the recipient of the inaugural British Kebab Awards last year, the feel is very different to what you'd expect to find at a late-night fast-food joint. This in part is down to the custom, 90 per cent of which comes from regulars rather than 3am drunkards, according to proprietor Hakan Topkaya.

The fruits of success lie in the 30-year family history of one of North London's first kebab houses, and the "standards,

taste and wisdom" that Topkaya insists have lived on. The tastes and flavours themselves have remained the same all the way through, as he has never changed the family recipe.

So what is it that makes this place stand out from the crowd? It is not simply its roll-call of celebrity punters, including Jeremy Corbyn MP (a falafel fan), the cast of EastEnders and former world heavyweight boxing champion Lennox Lewis. Neither is it the understated sign outside, part of a grand redesign which will feature rolling TV menus, making it appear more like an upmarket coffee shop than your average Islington kebab house.

Ultimately it's in the food, and this is where the Archway Kebab House steals a march over its rivals. Topkaya believes his customers maintain better figures than the average kebab eater because his food is marinated and only lightly salted, but a mouthful of the famous Archway Special would lead you to think otherwise.

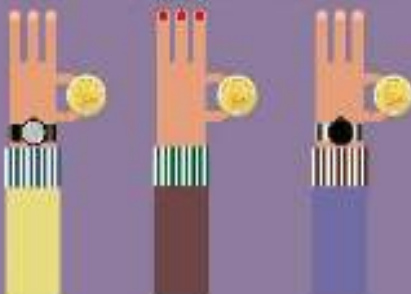
