

SUPPORT LOS ANGELES UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT WORKERS

WHEREAS the 30,000 Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) school workers represented by Service Employees International Union Local 99 are cafeteria workers, custodians, special education assistants, after school workers, bus drivers and thousands of other frontline staff that support student learning – inside and outside the classroom; and

WHEREAS one in three SEIU Local 99 members report having been homeless or on the brink of homelessness while working at LAUSD, while at the same time the state has seen the highest per-pupil funding rate in California history; and

WHEREAS members of SEIU Local 99 have been negotiating with LAUSD since April 2022, demanding equitable wage increases, more full-time work, respectful treatment, and increased staffing levels for improved student services;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Los Angeles County Democratic Party stands with SEIU Local 99 workers in their pursuit of equitable wage increases, full-time employment and respect in the workplace; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Los Angeles County Democratic Party calls on members of the Los Angeles Unified School District Board of Education to support fruitful negotiations that address the needs of LAUSD workers.
