Bulk Insurance Policy & Landcare Assistance Program (LAP) Insurance Grant		
Landcare Tasmania is able to offer funding for <b>public liability insurance</b> and <b>volunteer workers accident insurance</b> to your group by joining our Bulk Insurance Program. This insurance begins annually on 1 <sup>st</sup> of April. The premium is paid by Landcare Tasmania's Landcare Assistance Program (LAP) Insurance Grant, supported by the Tasmanian Government. There is no out-of-pocket expense to your group for this service, and you do not need to acquit this Insurance Grant (we already know where the funds were spent).
