When the LTN was introduced in June 2020, we leafleted 6000 homes, set up an online questionnaire, received over 940 responses, and published a report. We got **no response from your ward councillors**.

All year round we hold councillors to account by asking public questions at council meetings

- we are monitoring new housing developments and planning applications, especially the regeneration plans for Leigate.
- we are campaigning for step free access at our stations.
