FREEDOM POLICIES

EMPOWER CITIZENS & REDUCE THE COST OF LIVING FOR YOU AND YOUR FAMILY

1. CHEAP & RELIABLE ENERGY

Remove the ban on nuclear, stop subsidising unreliable energy sources and let private energy providers compete. Cheap energy reduces more than just your electricity bill. It reduces operating costs across the whole supply chain making everything you buy less expensive.

2. EMPOWER PARENTS NOT BUREAUCRATS

Direct existing funding to students, not institutions, with an education 'voucher'. Schools must then listen to parent concerns otherwise they will lose their funding if students move schools. Increased competition between schools to attract parents will lift education standards.

3. ABOLISH STAMP DUTY

Buying a house is hard enough without the government taking a cut. Abolishing it completely is a better way to reduce the cost of housing and help first home buyers instead of endless government schemes which distort the market. We are also opposed to an annual property tax.

4. ABOLISH PAYROLL TAX

Payroll tax is a nonsensical burden on businesses that hinders growth, increases operating costs and disincentivises hiring more employees. Abolishing it will boost the NSW economy and create more jobs.

5. REMOVE THE BURDENS ON SMALL BUSINESS

Red tape, green tape and licensing requirements drive up operating costs and make it harder to compete with big corporations. Small businesses must then charge higher prices to remain viable making their goods and services more expensive for you, the customer.

6. FIGHT FOR COVID JUSTICE

We will never forget the injustices perpetrated by the government on the Australian people over the last 3 years. We want a Royal Commission into Australia's COVID response including the extent of vaccine injuries. We can't let them do this to us again.
