- Print up and display posters throughout your area starting a few weeks before the collection
- Publicize the collection by sending an email to your members
- Make announcements during programming
- Ask local sports teams and their coaches to participate
- Partner with schools in the community to increase the impact of the collection. Ask to place bins in the school and have them publicize the project
- Contact sporting good stores in the community for potential donations

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q: How do we get the equipment to you?

A: There are 2 ways to get collected equipment to LPF:

1) You can drop the equipment off at our warehouse, located at:

Q: Can we receive a donation bin from the organization?
