National Program Coordination and Strategy

LHA coordinates several national programs with the support of member organisations and communities. Those programs span across mental health and suicide prevention, ageing and aged care, digital health, disability and sexual violence prevention. LHA is also engaged in developing support for programs and services across all areas where our communities experience significant health and wellbeing disparities, for example drug and alcohol, domestic and family violence, intimate partner violence, and cancer.

This is achieved through a highly experienced and passionate team, who are committed to ensuring the best possible outcomes for the communities LHA represent.

An LGBTIQ+ community-controlled organisation is an incorporated LGBTIQ+ organisation, initiated, based in and governed by members from LGBTIQ+ communities to deliver health and wellbeing services to LGBTIQ+ people and communities. The definition of health and wellbeing services and programs includes programs which address the social determinants of health.

CRITERIA FOR MEMBERSHIP INCLUDES:

- Can demonstrate being a LGBTIQ+ community controlled organisation providing health and wellbeing services
- Can demonstrate that the organisation is solely focused on promoting the health and wellbeing of lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and intersex people (to one or more group)
- Can demonstrate the delivery of LGBTIQ+ health and wellbeing services and programs either within a jurisdiction or nationally
- Can demonstrate that the organisation has a Board of Governance with more than 50% LGBTIQ+ representation
- Be an Australian incorporated not-for-profit
- Undertake to act lawfully and in a manner consistent with the objects of LGBTIQ+ Health Australia
- Required supporting documentation: Annual Report, Strategic Plan, Notice of Incorporation.

The definition of health and wellbeing services and programs includes programs which address the social determinants of health.

CRITERIA FOR MEMBERSHIP INCLUDES:

- Can demonstrate being a LGBTIQ+ community controlled group or organisation
- Can demonstrate that the group or organisation is solely focused on advocating for and promoting the health and wellbeing lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and intersex people (to one or more group)
- Can demonstrate the delivery of community activities and events, training and capacity building, policy and advocacy activities solely focused on advocating for and promoting the health and wellbeing of lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and intersex people (to one or more group)
- Can demonstrate that the organisation has a Board of Governance with greater than 50% LGBTIQ+ representation.
- For unincorporated entities demonstration of oversight and control is by LGBTIQ+ individuals
- Be an Australian incorporated not-for-profit
- Undertake to act lawfully and in a manner consistent with the objects of LGBTIQ+ Health Australia.
