My manifesto for the EoE Regional Chair is below:

8 Years Liberal Democrat member with experience in nearly every exec role and becoming a local party chair at 19.

This experience gives me invaluable experience in understanding how every exec role fits together to make a great local (or regional!) party.

3x council candidate who can support other candidates with advice and campaigning tips.

Chaired the 2019 General Election campaign where my local party held their deposit for the first time in 9 years.

Focused on improving youth representation across the region and getting more young people elected.

In my short time as Chair already (after being co-opted) I have already started to change older members' impression of Young Liberals and have been commended on this.

Support even more EoE Young Liberal members to access schemes such as Future Councillors and Young and Winning by exploring the obstacles and working to resolve them.

Managed to double my executive within 2 weeks of being chair.
