## LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY (LDEQ) DRIFTWOOD PIPELINE LLC - INDIAN BAYOU COMPRESSOR STATION PUBLIC HEARING AND REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON PROPOSED INITIAL PART 70 AIR OPERATING PERMIT & THE ASSOCIATED ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STATEMENT (EAS)

The LDEQ, Office of Environmental Services, will conduct a public hearing to receive comments on a Proposed Initial Part 70 Air Operating Permit and the associated Environmental Assessment Statement (EAS) for Driftwood Pipeline LLC, 1201 Louisiana St, Suite 3100, Houston, Texas 77002 for the Indian Bayou Compressor Station. The facility is located at 610 Gaytine Road, Ragley, Beauregard Parish. Take US 171 S from Ragley, travel approx. 4.5 mi south of the intersection of Hwy 12 and US 171 and turn left on Gaytine Road. Travel approx. 1 mi and the site will be on the right side of the road.

The hearing will be held on Tuesday, December 20, 2022, beginning at 6:00 p.m., at the DeRidder City Hall, 200 South Jefferson St., DeRidder, LA 70634. The hearing will be held in accordance with CDC guidance and in compliance with any guidelines issued by the Governor's office. During the hearing, all interested persons will have an opportunity to present oral statements, views, recommendations, opinions and information on the proposed permit. Additionally, written statements and other documents such as charts, data, and tabulations may be filed with the hearing officer at the hearing.

Driftwood Pipeline LLC requested an initial Part 70 Air Operating Permit.

A working draft of the proposed permit was submitted to the facility representative. Any remarks received during the technical review will be addressed in the "Worksheet for Technical Review of Working Draft of Proposed Permit". All the remarks received by LDEQ are included in the record that is available for public review.

The EAS submitted by the applicant addresses avoidance of potential and real environmental effects, balancing of social and economic benefits against environmental impact costs, and alternative sites, projects, and mitigative measures.

The public hearing will be conducted in accordance with La. R.S. 30:2017, which addresses the authority of the hearing officer, provides for the order in which speakers will be allowed to speak. A hearing officer will preside over the public hearing. This will be a formal hearing for the purpose of gathering facts and information. It will not include a "question and answer" component. In accordance with La. R.S. 30:2016, the hearing will be transcribed and become a part of the official public record.
