1. READING AND APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING'S MINUTES

The reading of the minutes was waived by a motion from the chair without objection from the membership.

2. OFFICER'S REPORTS

- a. Chairman
 - i. Maine got a bill passed that allows them to become a Major Party with only 5,000 registered Libertarians in the state (the equivalent in Connecticut would be 10-11,000 registered Libertarians). This removes the vast majority of the burden on Libertarian candidates and campaigns for gaining ballot access.
 - ii. Would like to look into getting a similar law passed here in Connecticut. Would like legislative research committee to look into if the bill could pass as is or would need to be tweaked to fit our local laws.

- iii. The next step after finalizing how the equivalent law would be written here would be to connect with other minor parties to lobby together to get it passed.
- b. Treasurer
 - i. Last Balance = \$16,065.18
 - ii. Expenditures = \$119.14
 - iii. Credits = \$267.00
 - **iv.** Current Balance = \$16,213.04
 - v. As of 07/24/2023
 - vi. 145.00 SCC voted on is not currently accounted for, check has yet to be cut.
- c. Secretary
 - The current Roster includes 447 total members, 163 Regular Members, 271 Associate Members, and 13 Lifetime Members. This is a decrease of 2 Regular Members, an increase of 3 Associate Members, and no change in Lifetime Members since the previous roster report on June 26th, 2023.
