

RESOLUTION OPPOSING WARRANTLESS MASS SURVEILLANCE AND FLOCK CAMERAS

WHEREAS, the fundamental goal of the Libertarian Party of Connecticut is the preservation of individual liberty, local sovereignty, and the protection of citizen privacy against state overreach; and

WHEREAS, the state and municipal proliferation of Automated License Plate Readers (ALPRs) and related surveillance networks—specifically centralized networks operated by private vendors—creates an automated dragnet of continuous, warrantless location tracking on public roads; and

WHEREAS, while individuals and private entities possess an undeniable right to record in public spaces, the state's centralization and real-time aggregation of citizen tracking data poses an unprecedented threat to free association, privacy, and presumption of innocence;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Libertarian Party of Connecticut condemns the deployment of mass surveillance technologies, including ALPRs and related surveillance networks, by any government entity in a manner that enables the collection and retention of data regarding the movements and activities of individuals without a warrant;
2. The Libertarian Party of Connecticut calls on candidates for the offices of Governor and General Assembly to clearly state their positions on ALPRs and related surveillance networks so voters on Election Day can accordingly express their preferences;
3. The Libertarian Party of Connecticut calls upon all federal, state, municipal, and other government entities to purge all data already collected; and
4. The Libertarian Party of Connecticut calls upon all federal, state, municipal, and other government entities operating within Connecticut to terminate and not enter into new contracts, data-sharing agreements, and other arrangements that facilitate warrantless mass surveillance.
