

Lesser Slave Watershed Council Elliott & Rosche Memorial Bursary

Application Form

BACKGROUND

This \$1,000 bursary is offered annually by the Lesser Slave Watershed Council in the memory of Brian Elliott and Brian Rosche, two of the founding Board members from the Lesser Slave Watershed Council. These two men contributed a significant amount of time and energy to the creation of the Lesser Slave Watershed Council, promoting watershed literacy, and to promoting the sustainability of our watershed. Recognized for their abilities to bring about the best in others and engage with others in the protection of our region's waterways, Mr. Elliott and Mr. Rosche's work will be memorialized through the recipient of this bursary.



BURSARY ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must:

- Be enrolled full time in a recognized academic program in Canada
- Students in grade twelve at the time of application; or students registered or currently attending a post-secondary institution in Canada
- Resident of the Lesser Slave Watershed for at least one year preceding the start of their program (see map here).
- Program must be in the sciences. E.g.) Environmental sciences, biology, ecology, geography, reclamation sciences, etc.

Application Must Include:

- Completed Application Form.
- Proof of residency: bill with address, photocopy of ID, etc.
- Two Letters of recommendation (e.g. former teacher, employer or other non-family member)
- Proof of enrollment or official transcript from the academic institution
- Brief personal essay answering the following questions: How will this bursary support your academic pursuits? In what ways have/will you contribute to the communities in our watershed? Please keep under 500 words.
- Resume: Please include relevant extracurricular, volunteer experiences & work history

Before applying, please remember...

In order to be eligible for the Elliott & Rosche Memorial Bursary, you must have been a resident of the Lesser Slave Watershed for at least one year prior to application. Students who are from communities within the watershed, but who moved away to pursue post-secondary studies are still eligible, so long as they have been a resident of the region (i.e. attended high school in High Prairie, Slave Lake, Kinuso, Swan Hills, etc.) and have proof of residency.
