Our graduates are drawn from multiple sectors, including business, the military, charities, the NHS, local government and the trade union movement, as well as those with full-time caring responsibilities. We are constantly reviewing the level of diversity of our trainees and working to improve it. Since 2021 we found that, of our trainees:
