Josh Kurtz is a veteran chronicler of Maryland politics and government as well as founder of *Maryland Matters*, a 9-year-old nonprofit news website that covers Maryland government and politics. He began covering the State House in 1995 for *The Gazette* newspapers in Montgomery County and has been writing about state and local politics ever since. He was an editor at *Roll Call*, the Capitol Hill newspaper, for eight years, and for eight years was the editor of *E&E Daily*, which covers energy and environmental policy on Capitol Hill. Kurtz has also worked as a reporter in New Mexico, New York and Wisconsin, and spent three years in an apprentice program for the *New York Times*. Josh has a BA in History from the University of Wisconsin and an MS in Journalism from Columbia University.
