The League of Women Voters of Carroll County encourages and values comments on our social media platforms. To ensure that these spaces remain welcoming and respectful, we reserve the right to delete comments that contain, constitute, or link to:

- Vulgar, obscene, or abusive language or images
- Personal attacks, name-calling, insults, or threatening language of any kind
- Hate speech directed at any individual or group based on race, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, ethnicity, age, religion, or disability
- Personal identifying information such as phone numbers or email addresses
- Advertisements, promotions, or solicitations for commercial products or services
- Clearly off-topic discussions
- Disruptively repetitive content
- Comments that advocate illegal activity
- Malicious or harmful software
- Copyrighted materials in violation of state or federal law

Individuals who violate this policy may be temporarily or permanently banned from commenting or viewing the League's social media pages without notice.
