

Support HB1847/SB2128
Hold Data Centers responsible for infrastructure costs

This bill requires data center owners to pay the full cost of infrastructure needed to support their facilities, including electric utility infrastructure. Currently, those costs can be distributed to other ratepayers.

Why it matters: Tennessee ratepayers should not have to subsidize infrastructure costs of data centers through their utility bills.

This bill will be heard in two committees this week. Your calls or emails before they vote will help legislators know that constituents want this protection.
