QUESTION PERIOD: COMLUX AVIATION & UKRAINIAN REFUGEES



During Question Period in the House of Commons, I asked why the Liberal government is in no rush to bring in Ukrainian refugees that they have approved. Trudeau had blocked Comlux Aviation from flying refugees to Canada for free, and transporting humanitarian aid back... all because the main pilot was not Covid-19 vaccinated.

Good news & BIG WIN! The day after asking this question in Parliament, the government stopped placing illogical roadblocks upon these Ukrainian refugee flights to Canada. First flight is scheduled for July 4th to Saskatchewan. These flights are for approved refugees with visas, most of whom have lost their homes and possessions fleeing from the Russian invaders. Thank you to Sherard Soparkar from Maple Ridge for meeting with me about this situation and being an advocate!
