### A MESSAGE FROM MP DALTON

Dear Neighbour,

Over 6 million Canadians don't have access to a family doctor. Many living in Pitt Meadows and Maple Ridge are not under the care of a family physician, waiting hours at a local walk-in clinic just for basic care. Of those who do, 41 percent say they still have a hard time getting timely appointments.

There are 53,005 nurses and doctors living in Canada trained abroad who are not able to practice. They could be filling the doctor/nurse shortages and provide desperately needed care for Canadians. For one reason or another, they can't. Much of this is due to layer upon layer of bureaucracy.

I met Bill (pictured) at my recent meet and greet. He just became a Canadian and was a highly skilled surgeon in Europe. Yet, he has been unable to practice as a doctor because of government bureaucracy.

#### Conservatives have the Solution:

A Conservative government, led by Poilievre, will work with provinces and the healthcare sector to establish a na-

tional competency body that will set standards just like the Canadian Council of Directors of Apprenticeship (CCDA) does for the Red Seal certificate that exists for trades.

In cooperation with provinces and territories, create a standard so foreign-trained health professionals get a chance to take the test and get an answer within 60 days.

Bill C-11

Bill C-11 aims to regulate digital streaming platforms such as Netflix, YouTube and Spotify. Bill C-11 will give the CRTC new powers, including the ability to impose financial penalties against people and businesses that violate certain provisions of the Broadcasting Act or its regulations.
