Freeholder Charles Kenny is a graduate of Middlesex County College, class of 2009 and has been a lifelong resident of Woodbridge Township. Freeholder Kenny began his career in public service in 1995, serving as Ward One, District Nine Democratic County Committeeman in Woodbridge. Elected in 1997, he joined the Township Council as the First Ward Representative. Mr. Kenny has also served as the Woodbridge Township Council President. Some of Mr. Kenny's proudest accomplishments as a councilman were helping to guide new small businesses, and helping existing businesses to flourish. He was also instrumental in creating emergency service systems, a municipal skatepark, and a dog park in Woodbridge in order to help bring the entire community come together.

Freeholder Kenny has served on the Middlesex County Board of Chosen Freeholders since 2013, and currently Chairs the Infrastructure Management Committee. This committee oversees all County-run buildings, roads, properties, parks, conservation areas, and more. Under Freeholder Kenny's leadership, the County works to maintain over 8,000 acres for Open Space, and over 5,400 acres for Farmland Preservation. Under Freeholder Kenny's leadership, the County also maintains a robust Capital Improvement program to repave roads, replace culverts, improve parks, and enhance the safety and well-being of County residents. Freeholder Kenny is also overseeing the County's Destination 2040 Planning Initiative. Destination 2040 is the process of developing a comprehensive plan for Middlesex County that will shape how the County will grow in the coming years, and drive strategic investment in transportation, economic development, and more.

Freeholder Kenny is a career firefighter in Woodbridge. Joining the Woodbridge Fire Department in 1985, he was promoted to the rank of Captain in 1995. In 2018, he was promoted to serve as the first-ever Administrative Fire Chief for Fire District Number 1 in Woodbridge. In addition to his service on the Freeholder Board and as a firefighter, Freeholder Kenny serves on numerous local boards and committees in Woodbridge.


