Assemblywoman Nancy Pinkin, a resident of East Brunswick, was first elected to the General Assembly in November 2013 and twice re-elected in 2015 and 2017.

The Assemblywoman runs her own healthcare and association management consulting firm and has an extensive background in healthcare administration, with an expertise in ambulatory care and medical practice management. She is also the Executive Director of the Middlesex and Mercer County Medical Societies.

Pinkin served on the East Brunswick Township Council from 2005-2014, including a two year term as Council President.

She received her undergraduate degree from Rutgers while working full time. She holds a Master of Public Administration with a specialization in health administration from New York University, and completed a postgraduate fellowship in Health Policy and Research at UMDNJ -- where she also served as health policy advisor to the late Senator Jack Sinagra.

Assemblywoman Pinkin is the Chair of the Assembly Environment and Solid Waste Committee. She is the Vice Chair of the Assembly Health and Senior Services Committee and serves as a member of the Assembly Law and Public Safety Committee.

She has also been appointed to serve on the Governor's Advisory Council on HIV/AIDS and Related Blood-Borne Pathogens, the New Jersey Disparity in State Procurement Study Commission, the Council of State Governments – Eastern Regional Conference Energy and Environment Committee, and the New Jersey Legislative Select Oversight Joint Committee.

A few of the awards that the Assemblywoman has received are the “Outstanding Women in Government Award” at the New Jersey State League of Municipalities, the 2019 Sierra Club Award, the “Congressman Dean A. Gallo Memorial Award for Distinguished Legislative Leadership”, and the South Asian Community Outreach (SACO) “Leadership and Service Award”.

Her and husband, Dr. James Salwitz, are the proud parents of two children and two grandchildren.

Assemblywoman Pinkin represents the 18th Legislative District which includes East Brunswick, Edison, Helmetta, Highland Park, Metuchen, South Plainfield and South River.
