We support our communities at all stages in life take control of their sexual health by providing information, workshops and a range of support services to inform, educate and arm you with the knowledge you need to keep your sex life healthy.

Our message to you is simple – Know your sexual health status. Know your risks and manage your sex life with confidence. Protect yourself and your sexual partners. With the right information, the right advice and the right people to talk to, you can significantly reduce your risk of HIV, an STI, or passing these on to a sexual partner.

Meridian host STRIP every month (Meridian's sexual health clinic) with our partner, Canberra Sexual Health Centre. STRIP offers free sexual health check-ups for all LGBTIQ+ people in Canberra. This includes a comprehensive range of tests and free, confidential advice. Meridian also distributes hundreds of thousands of condoms each year.



Meridian provides peer navigation services. We provide the opportunity of people to talk to their peers in a safe community controlled space. We have peer navigators who understand sexual health and are HIV peer workers, SWOP Educators and participate in our regular peer led community groups.



Meridian offers a Pop Up GP Clinic on Thursdays, thanks to Hobart Place General Practice providing sexual health support and gender affirmation care-initial assessment and advice.



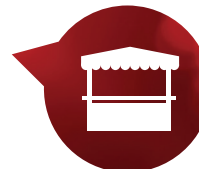
Meridian provides safe spaces for communities to come together to talk about sex, sexuality, relationships and sexual safety.
