*By Notice of the Chief Electoral Officer on this day, **September 2, 2025**; a By-Election for **Provincial Women's Representative** of the Otipemisiwak Métis Government shall be held, with the final day of voting to be **November 22, 2025**.*

Nomination Packages will be available by request to the Office of the Chief Electoral Officer beginning **September 2, 2025**. To request a package, you may email Elections@metis.org, call Toll-Free @ 1-877-576-4250 or visit the office of the Chief Electoral Officer to pick one up.

- All nomination papers must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. MT on **October 02, 2025**.
- Nomination papers must be delivered in person or via mail to the Office of the Chief Electoral Officer in Edmonton, Alberta. Electronically submitted nomination papers will not be accepted.

VOTING DETAILS

Voters must be Métis Nation within Alberta Citizens and (16) years of age or older to be entitled to vote for Provincial Women's Representative.

The exact addresses for each polling location are to be determined, along with any additional locations that may be deemed necessary and approved by the Chief Electoral Officer in consultation with District Leadership.

All polling station hours will operate from **8am to 8pm**.

Mail-in Voting

- A mail-in ballot package will be sent via mail to each Citizen who is eligible to vote.
- Mail-in ballot packages will be sent to the address on file with the Otipemisiwak Métis Government Registrar.
- If a mail-in ballot is not received, or a replacement mail-in ballot package is required, Citizens should make this request no later than 10 days (November 12, 2025) prior to Count Day.

Electronic Voting

Electronic voting will be open for the entire duration of the voting period which is from **November 16 - 22, 2025.**

Name/Mailing Address Opt-Out

The list of voters will be distributed to each candidate. *Note that a candidate for Provincial Women's Representative is entitled to receive a list of all of the voters who are eligible to vote in this election. Citizens may opt-out of having their name and/or mailing address included on the list of voters that will be circulated to candidates.
