In-Person Voting	November 3, 2026 from 8:00 AM – 8:00 PM	The exact addresses of each polling location will be announced at a later date
Mail-In Voting	October 26 – November 3, 2026	Mail-in ballots will be sent out to all eligible voters by October 5, 2026.
Electronic Voting	October 26 – November 3, 2026	Registration for electronic ballots will open on October 23, 2026.

Voter Eligibility:

- Voters must be Métis Nation within Alberta Citizens,
- (16) years of age or older and
- ordinarily resident in their respective District, for at least 90 days before November 3, 2026.

In the Jasper House Métis District, only voters residing in the Edson or Jasper-Grande Cache sub-districts will be eligible to vote.
