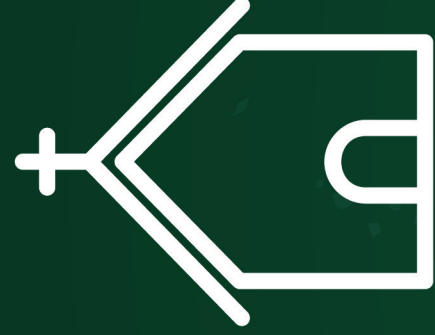


Families of Nonpublic School Students



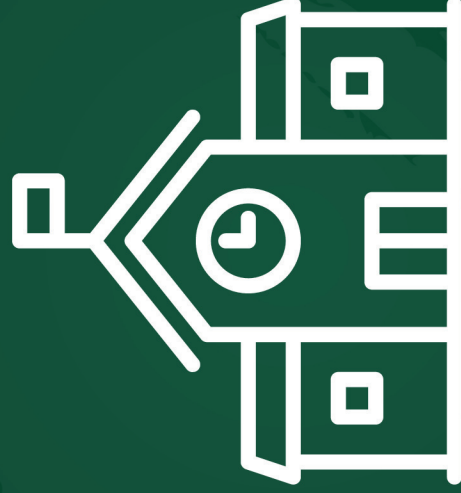

Nonpublic Schools

Nonpublic schools report the number of students with parental permission to participate in Per Pupil Aid program to LEAs. They also provide their preference for services and materials, although LEAs make final decisions.



Public School Districts/LEA

After receiving nonpublic per pupil aid funding and transportation dollars directly from the state, LEAs make final decisions on purchasing and allocation of:

- *Nursing*
- *Counseling*
- *Standardized test materials*
- *Busing*
- *Textbooks and course material*

Services and materials purchased by LEAs go direct to students.



Nonpublic Students

Nonpublic students receive fewer full-time employees for nursing and counseling than public students.
