

## **DECLARATION OF INTENT TO SEEK OFFICE**

Eligibility for Election: Article V and Article VI of the NACOLE Bylaws provide that candidates for office shall have been a regular or organizational member of the association, in good standing for one (1) year and have attended at least one (1) of the two previous annual conferences. Those who are organizational members must be the designated voter of their organization. Members standing for election as President shall have been elected as a member of the Board of Directors and shall have served in that capacity for no less than two (2) years. Members standing for election as Vice-President shall have been elected as a member of the Board of Directors and shall have served in that capacity for no less than one (1) year. Dues must be current for the membership year 2023-2024. The membership will elect the President, the Vice-President, and three (3) Board members-at-large at the Annual Meeting on November 15, 2023.
